

**LOUGH CUTRA CASTLE TRIATHLON CAMPSITE RULES**  
**25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> MAY 2018**

**1. DIRECTIONS AND ACCESS TO THE CAMPSITE**

From Dublin: Follow the N6 for Galway. At Loughrea avoid the bypass signposted for Gort, but head straight on into the town. At the end of the town turn left at the Westbridge onto the N66 signposted for Gort. Entering Gort turn left at the T Junction onto the N18. After c. 2 miles there is a small road to the left. Take this and immediately in front of you are the Main Gates to Lough Cutra Castle.

From Shannon: Take the N66 northbound for Ennis and Galway. After Ennis continue through Crusheen. After c. 5 miles there is a small car sales forecourt. Take the next right turn onto a small road (c. 0.75 miles) and the main entrance to Lough Cutra Castle is on your right.

**GATE CODE ON ENTRY:** Enter through the castle through the Main Gates using the unique code **1608** and follow the signs to the Campsite.

On Friday and Saturday the Camping area will open for access from 5pm. Please drive to the castle entrance following the "Triathlon Campsite" signs marked from all directions. Once inside the allocated camp ground you have access on foot to the castle grounds (limited access) and the race village. On Saturday the Camping area is accessible all day.

On Sunday no vehicles will be able to leave the Campsite until after all racing is completed (approx 5:00pm)

On Monday the campsite must be cleared by no later than midday.

No vehicles will be allowed to move on the site whilst racing is underway.

**2. NO ARRIVAL AFTER 10PM.**

Many of the campers will have had very long days or may be on site with children and wish to go to sleep early. As a result, we cannot allow entry onto the site after 10pm. The gate code will be disabled between 10pm and 5.00am.

**3. RUBBISH**

Any rubbish, which you bring on site, will you please take it out with you or deposit it in the rubbish containers provided.

**4. STANDPIPE**

There will be potable running cold water available from a standpipe.

**5. DOGS**

Dogs are not allowed on site.

## **6. FOOD AND DRINK**

Food and drink will be available for purchase on site on race day only. The town of Gort, with excellent local pubs and restaurants is a 10 minute drive from the campsite.

## **7. FACILITIES**

There will be sufficient toilet and showering facilities available in the campsite. Showers are in the Stable Block – their specific use will be brief on arrival. Signs will take people from the campsite to the Stable Block.

## **8. SECURITY AND GATE CODE**

Security will be provided on Friday and Saturday nights. We have an all night walk around security guard on site at all times. The main gate code throughout your stay will be code **1608**. On exit drive up to the gates and they will open automatically.

## **9. ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR**

This is a family campsite and antisocial behaviour of any description will not be tolerated.

## **10. CASTLE AND ESTATE ACCESS**

There will be no access to the Castle itself through the course of the weekend. You are permitted to move around the estate (at your own risk) on the marked roads, tracks and paths but please steer clear of any livestock or other estate buildings.

## **12. DEPARTURE**

Due to the location of the campsite adjacent to the main estate road no campers will be able to leave the site until after competition on both Saturday and Sunday of the event – **this will be at approximately 5.00pm each day**. The campsite manager will advise you of this timing.
