



**Cholmondeley Castle Triathlon**  
**Campsite Rules – 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> June 2018**

Pitch (2 people) £25.00,  
Extra Person £8.00 per night (6yrs and over)

**1. DIRECTIONS AND ACCESS TO THE CAMP SITE**

Cholmondeley Castle is located off the A49 Whitchurch / Tarporley Road, between Warrington and Whitchurch. The entrance to the castle is off the A49 at the Cholmondeley Arms Pub crossroads - postcode: SY14 8HN. Follow signs to Cholmondeley Castle from these crossroads and take the first right, which will take you towards the estate office. Drive for approximately 400m along a wiggly lane and you will come to some blue gates at the entrance to the estate. Drive at these and they will open. Then drive for a further 100m and take your first left immediately followed by a sharp right-hand turn. Make your way down this avenue of trees and the lake and campsite will appear on your left-hand side. The campsite entrance and area is signposted at this point. See mp below.

On Friday the Camping area will open for access from 5pm. On Saturday, access is from 5.30pm, due to the mixed relay. If you arrive before these times please follow signs to the triathlon car park and you are welcome to wait there.

Upon arrival please report to the Campsite Manager. If the Campsite Manager is unavailable when you arrive (e.g. during competition), please pitch appropriately and report in, or he'll find you, later when he returns.

From the campsite you have access on foot to the castle grounds (limited access) and the event village. Please do not cross over the ha ha (an ornamental ditch) and onto the actual castle lawn. No vehicles will be allowed to move on the site whilst racing is underway. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas when the gates are open to the public.

Nearest Railway stations are at Chester, Crewe and Whitchurch.

**2. ARRIVAL AFTER 10 PM.**

Many of the campers will have had very long days or may be on site with children and wish to go to sleep early. As a result any camper who cannot arrive by car before 22.00hrs or who wants to leave and come back on site must take special care not to wake others on arrival.

**3. RUBBISH**

Any rubbish, which you bring on site, will you please take it out with you or deposit it in the rubbish containers provided.

**4. DOGS**

Well-behaved dogs are allowed on site. Please clear up any dog mess that they may leave behind.



#### 5. FOOD AND DRINK

Food and drink will be available for purchase on site on race days only.  
The Cholmondeley Arms, an excellent local pub, is a 15-minute walk from the campsite.

#### 6. FACILITIES

There will be sufficient toilet and showering facilities available adjacent to the campsite.  
There are no electric hookup points or foul/soiled water disposal points.  
Running cold water will be available from a fixed standpipe.

#### 7. SECURITY

Security will be provided on Friday and Saturday nights. We have an all night walk around security guard on site at all times.

#### 8. ANTISOCAL BEHAVIOUR

This is a family campsite and antisocial behavior of any description will not be tolerated.
