

Chateau de Chantilly - Triathlon, Swim, Run and Multisport Event 29/30 August 2020

Due to social distance measures, we have had to implement a new pre-event process for all participants. Don't worry it's quick and simple!

Check List

The first 3 steps below can be carried out at the same time via your Activeworks account by logging into 'MYEVENTS'.

1. Informing us of your estimated swim or run time
2. If necessary, purchasing a Competition Day Pass
3. Submitting your race licence documentation.
4. Downloading a Spectator Ticket (if required)

**The deadline to upload the required documentation is
Midnight Monday 17th August using your ACTIVE account.
Without valid documentation we cannot allow participation in the event!**

1. Estimated Swim Time

We are asking that all participants give us their estimated swim or run time. This will help us set up start times, letting the faster participants go first to help reduce overcrowding on the course. Starts will be restricted to 5 participants in a wave with a 45 second gap between waves.

Login to [MYEVENTS](#) / Find your 2020 Château de Chantilly booking / Use the EDIT REGISTRATION button to find the 'Estimate your Swim or Run Time' section / Choose from the dropdown of timings / Don't forget to click apply or save!

2. Purchase your Competition Day Pass

This applies to participants in the Triathlon, Duathlon, Aquabike & Aquathlon. If you do not hold a competitive licence with a Triathlon Governing body (eg BTF), you need to pay the Competition Pass fee via MYEVENTS.

Login to [MYEVENTS](#) / Find your 2020 Château de Chantilly booking / Use the ADD MERCHANDISE button to find the 'Competition Pass' section / Choose the correct Pass and complete purchase.

3. Race day documentation requirement New procedure applicable to ALL PARTICIPANTS!

(also accessed by MYEVENTS)

All Licence documentation requirements must be submitted online via Activeworks before race day.

A participant can bring 1 supporter to the event. There is no charge but supporters need to download a spectator ticket. For a visit on Saturday AND Sunday, it is necessary to place 2 orders of the free tickets.
